Good Morning,

After the end of the first quarter of the year, I wanted to take a moment to update you on some statistics that you may find of interest.

First Quarter Finances:

For the first quarter of the year the weekly offerings have totaled \$126,277 or 23.43% of the yearly budget. Each week our congregation needs \$10,363.58 cents to meet the yearly budget, and to date our church has given on average \$9,713.62 each week. This is a difference of \$650 each week. Not too bad for the first quarter considering church was not held one Sunday in January because of weather.

First Quarter Worship Attendance and Membership:

To date, twenty six adults have joined the church in 2008. This is a increase from 7 in 2007. Also, total worship attendance has increased a by 104 person . This is a significant increase from 237 in 2007, to 341 in 2008.

I do not believe that these increases can be attributed to any one person or group of people. Truly, each of you has played an important part in this church's growing success. However, as we study the seven deadly sins, let us be care not to become prideful. Let us give God the glory!
